Our mission is to mobilize volunteers and community partners in building safe, affordable housing, and promoting home ownership while breaking the cycle of poverty. We believe in building a community where everyone has a safe, affordable place to live. We are currently beginning a build of 2 detached homes on Donald Street in Belleville.

You Can Give a Hand Up by “Adopting-a-Day”

Our **Adopt-a-Day Sponsorship** program is a way in which our community can support the Habitat for Humanity Prince Edward-Hastings mission by building a home for a deserving local family. It is a fun, meaningful and productive opportunity to promote volunteerism within your organization. Your team members will receive a free T-shirt, refreshments, lunch and photos of their experience. Media will be made aware in advance of your company’s participation in our build and photo’s will be sent to all major media outlets.

“ADOPT-A-DAY” SPONSORSHIP

To reserve the **BELLEVILLE BUILDSITE** we ask for a \$1,000 sponsorship from your company or pledges (\$20 and over receives a tax receipt) for a team of 5-15 people. You will experience working together while investing in your community with your time, talent and treasure. *100%* of the donated proceeds go towards the Habitat house that your team will work on.

How does it work?

- * Choose a date at least three weeks in advance
- * Choose a Team Leader to communicate with our Fund Development Coordinator
- * Recruit your team mates
- * Team Leader must confirm number of volunteers five days prior to event
- * The team will fill out necessary forms and watch an online safety video
- * Participating employees / group members collectively raise pledges
- * Arrive at the job site on your designated day with your pledge sheets and money (bring a sign to display on the site!)
- * Enjoy working together on a variety of tasks such as painting, siding, building a deck, installing fixtures, or insulating the Habitat home.
- * Share a delicious lunch with your team mates
- * Complete the day with group photos and a Habitat t-shirt to remind you of your good work and wear it with pride!

What can you expect when you Adopt-a-Day?

We begin at 8:30am with an orientation/safety chat. Once the hard hats and steel toed boots are fastened, the fun begins!

The Construction Supervisor will direct each person according to their level of experience and supervise their work throughout the day. You will work together, laugh together and give a family hope for their future.

Lunch is provided, and the day ends at 3:30pm.

We suggest you wear comfortable clothing, and bring your own refillable water bottle.

Steel toed boots and hard hats are provided; but bring your own if you have them!
